

CARDBOARD BOAT RACE

2011 RULES

1. Have Fun - Safely!!!!
2. ALL BOAT OCCUPANTS MUST WEAR a properly fastened life jacket while in the boat.
3. Children under the age of 13 MUST HAVE an adult in the boat with them.
4. Boat hulls must be constructed entirely of corrugated cardboard. Any thickness of cardboard is permitted. Caulking and taping may be used but only in seams, edges, and joints. Other materials may include: duct tape and one-part paint or glue. .
5. Absolutely **NO** use of the following items: Tar-based substances, two-part varnishes, fiberglass resin, epoxy glue, waxed cardboard, carpet tubes and barrels, plastic, wood, rubber, foam cellular or flotation materials, or any other two-part substances or corrugated cardboard that's bonded to any material. **NO** wrapping of the entire hull with duct tape, plastic, shrink-wrap, or other materials.
6. Boats are to be propelled by oars or paddles.
7. Your boat must be free of sharp edges, pointed objects, or anything else that could cause injuries.
8. The boat's passenger area must not be permanently enclosed above the occupants shoulders. Each person must be visible while the boat is in the water.
9. No more than 2 humans allowed in any boat.
10. To qualify as a finisher you must be **IN** your boat, not towing it in your teeth or between your legs, nor pushing or swimming with boat.
11. Boat occupants must wear shoes with a substantial sole to eliminate injury. **NO** flip flops are allowed.
12. **NO** ALCOHOL
